By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned order dated 19.12.2017 (Annexure P-9) passed by respondent No.4.

Learned counsel states that in the earlier writ petition No.25549-2017, filed by the petitioner, this Court while disposing of the same had issued directions to respondent No.4 to consider the representation dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-4). The respondent was further directed that in case the name of the petitioner is found to be in the waiting list and the posts are still lying vacant, the petitioner be considered as per his merit. However, the waiting list as per the merit has not yet been prepared.

Heard.

In view of the stand taken by the State, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction

to the respondents to complete the exercise for preparation of merit list of the waiting candidates within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, the vacancies are available, in such eventuality, the consequential order be passed as directed by this Court in CWP-25549-2017 (Annexure P-8) to him, within a period of three months thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
