The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 & 5 who forcible recovered truck/vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No. PB 05 AR 9507 with the help of recovery agents and henchmen while it was moving on road.

In compliance of order dated 29.07.2024 passed by this Court, status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Brij Mohan, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Industrial Area-B, Ludhiana, has been filed in the Court today on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State and the same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel at the very outset submits that nothing survives in the present petition as during the pendency of the same, a compromise has been effected between the parties and the statement of the

petitioner was recorded in which he has categorically stated that he does not want any action against respondents No.4 and 5 with regard to his representation dated 15.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) and the petitioner has further undertaken to withdraw the present petition.

In view of the status report and the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed and the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
