

PUJA AND ANOTHER V/S STATE OF HARYANA AND OTHERS

for the petitioners.

1. By filing present petition, under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners seek necessary protection of their lives and personal liberty in view of the fact that **they are living in a live-in relationship** and are under eminent threats at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 is already married to respondent No.4, however, no child is born out of the said wedlock. It is stated that petitioners are living in a live-in relationship against the wishes of their family members, who are allegedly threatening them and interfering in their personal lives. Hence, the petitioners are seeking protection in that regard and have approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition. They have also submitted a representation dated 02.06.2025 (Annexure P-3), to respondent No.2-the Superintendent of Police, Nuh, wherein, they have expressed their apprehension.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, such direction petitions are entertained, all matrimonial laws would be of no meaning and there would be strong chances that the run away couple, who are already

married with some other person, may use the Courts' order as shield to justify their relations, which may even not be recognized under law.

5. Be that as it may, the scope of this Court is only to examine the threat perception to the lives of the persons and not beyond that, therefore, let a status report be filed by learned State Counsel after examining the facts and circumstances in its entirety and respondent No.2 would ensure that any such incident as expressed by the petitioners do not happen till the next date of hearing.
