SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of the BNSS, seeking issuance of directions to Respondents No. 2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against the private respondents for theft, tampering, and destruction of documents related to the departmental inquiry. Further, the petition seeks directions to consider and act upon the applications dated 03.01.2024 (P-1) and 13.05.2025 (P-2) submitted by the petitioner.

2. On 07.07.2025, following order was passed:

“1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, seeking issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3, to take legal action against the private respondents, and to further take action on the application dated 03.01.2024 and 13.05.2025, submitted by him.

2. Counsel for the petitioner seeks an adjournment to cite the judgment(s) to argue that the direction which is sought through present petition, can be issued under Section 528 of BNSS.

3. On request, adjourned to 08.07.2025.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for.
