1. The petitioners pray for protection of their life and liberty from the hands of respondent no.4 and 5, who are brother and mother of petitioner no.1. Originally, the property was owned by late Sh. Babu Ram, who is alleged to have executed a Will in favour of his wife namely Smt.Bimla Devi (respondent no.5). The petitioners allege that respondent no.4 and 5 assaulted the petitioners on 05.06.2025. They are forcing the petitioners to hand over vacant possession of the property.

2. In the facts of this case, the petitioners, if so advised, may avail the remedy of filing an injunction suit. However, no ground to issue any writ for protection of their life and liberty is required to be passed.
