1. This order shall dispose of two petitions i.e. CWP Nos. 24162 and 23111 of 2018.

2. Grievance raised by petitioner(s) in both writ petitions was of their goods being detained allegedly in an illegal manner despite deposit of 10% of tax demand. Vide order dated 22.10.2018, it was directed that goods in

question be released on furnishing security other than bank guarantee or cash. It is recorded in order dated 10.04.2019 that goods in question had been released to the petitioners in both writ petitions.

The Court was informed on 05.08.2024 by Ms. Muskan Gupta, Advocate that files of writ petitions had been returned to petitioner(s) for engaging another counsel.

Today, none appears on behalf of petitioner(s) in both writ petitions. It appears that petitioners are not interested in pursuing the matter any longer.

Both the petitions are, accordingly, dismissed in default and for non-prosecution.
