1. On 29.09.2025, the following order was passed:

"By order dated 19.09.2019, it was ordered that matter be listed after adjudication of FIR No.113 dated 21.07.2012 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner has been acquitted vide judgment dated 01.08.2022 passed by trial Court in aforesaid FIR.

The petitioner is seeking counting of dismissal period in his length of service. The petitioner joined as Constable in 1979. He from time to time was promoted to higher ranks. He was implicated in four FIRs. Detail of FIRs is as below:

The moment FIR No.247 dated 13.10.2010 was registered, the petitioner was arrested and suspended from service. He remained in judicial custody till 05.01.2011. He was acquitted vide judgment dated 12.10.2012 in FIR No.247 dated 13.10.2010. He was reinstated w.e.f. 07.02.2016 without back wages.

As per reply, petitioner was involved in money lending business. On two occasions, he lent money and thereafter fraudulently got transferred property of the borrower either in his name or in the name of relatives. He on one occasion detained one vehicle, however, illegally released pretending as if it was never detained. On account of his illegal acts and conduct, he was implicated in aforesaid FIRs.

The Registry is directed to send notice by registered post to the petitioner.

Adjourned to 30.10.2025."

2. As per office report, notice issued to petitioner has not been received back served or otherwise. It appears that with the efflux of time, petitioner has lost his interest to pursue the matter.

3. **Dismissed** with liberty to petitioner to move an appropriate application within three months from today, if cause survives.
