This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the B.N.S.S,2023 read with Section 3(1)(d) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act 1962, seeking direction to the official respondents to decide the representation (on the basis of letter issued by respondent no. 2 (Annexure P-2), filed by the petitioner vide which he is seeking for 10 weeks parole to meet with his family member and the application is pending since last 6 months, (Annexure P-3) as the respondent no.2 and respondent no. 3 delay the matter on the ground of jurisdiction and prejudice the right of the petitioner with the reason best known to him and now the application of the petitioner is lying pending in the office of respondent no.1 since last one month vide diary number 460/PB dated 16.05.2025.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to look into the

representation dated 05.05.2025 (Annexure P-3), within a time bound manner.

Without adverting to the merits of the case and in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.2-The District Magistrate, Hisar is directed to look into the representation dated 05.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. The order so passed in the said representation shall be communicated to the petitioner within a period of one week thereafter.

The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
