1. At the outset, learned State counsel has stated on instructions from ASI Kewal Kumar that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 29.07.2024, the petitioner has already joined investigation and he has fully cooperated with the investigation process and he is not required for custodial interrogation. He further submitted that in the present case, it was a dispute between neighbours over a car parking and the injuries, if any, were simple in nature.

2. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed. It is directed that in case in future the petitioner is required to join the investigation process, then he shall join the investigation



and cooperate fully with the investigation process. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Arresting/Investigating Officer on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction, subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
