This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, has been filed for issuance of necessary directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents (arrayed in the petition).

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 25.06.2025, this Court had directed the State to evaluate the threat perception as alleged through the instant petition, if any, and file a status report with respect to the same.

3. In compliance to the said order, learned State counsel has filed the status report in Court today which is taken on record. Relevant portion of the same reads thus:

“6. That so far as the allegations levelled by the present petitioner Manpreet Kaur against the private respondents No.4 to 8 with respect to extending her life threats and having given the representation dated 13.06.2025 (Annexure P/6) against them to the respondent Nos.2 & 3 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar and SHO PS Mohkampura, Amritsar, are concerned, it



is submitted that based on the enquiry conducted and evaluation qua threat perception made by SHO PS Mohkampura, Amritsar, the petitioner Manpreet Kaur has not been found having any danger/threat from the private respondent Nos.4 to 8 and the petitioner herself has stated in her statement that she has not given any application-representation against the respondent No.s4 to 8. The respondent Nos.4 to 8 are willing to keep the petitioner Manpreet Kaur with them but the petitioner Manpreet Kaur is not willing to live with them and she is living in live-in relationship with the aforesaid Krishan Singh. As of now, the petitioner Manpreet Kaur is not found having any danger/threat from the private respondents and she does not require any security. However, the Police Department is duty bound to protect life and liberty of every citizen and the deponent has issued direction to SHO PS Mohkampura, Amritsar to keep surveillance on both the parties in order to thwart any untoward incident in future. The report of SHO PS Mohkampura, Amritsar is annexed herewith as Annexure R-1/T for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court."

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not controverted the aforesaid factual aspect.
5. In view of the above, nothing survives in this petition.
6. The petition stands disposed of.
7. Pending application, if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
