1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondent No.1 & 2 to release the petitioner temporarily on parole for 06 weeks under Section 3 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners Temporary Release Act, 1988 as amended by (Amendment Act), 2022.

In compliance of the order dated 09.07.2025, learned State counsel has filed the status report dated 18.07.2025 by way of affidavit of Mr. Naresh Kumar Goel, Superintendent of Police, District Prison, Gurugram on behalf of the respondent-State, which is taken on record and submits that the application of the petitioner seeking parole dated 07.07.2025 (Annexure R-2) has been forwarded vide letter No. 7379-82 (Annexure R-3) on 10.07.2025 for necessary consideration and decision on the same.

Learned State counsel further assures the Court that necessary action will be taken on the said application of the petitioner within a period of three days from today.

In light of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner being satisfied on the basis of assurance given by learned State counsel and does not want to press the instant petition any further at this stage to await the final outcome of the above said application which have been forwarded on 10.07.2025.

The present petition stands dismissed as not pressed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the instant petition by moving application, in case, the aforesaid assurance given by the State counsel is not adhered to by the authorities.
