1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 (earlier Section 439 Cr.P.C.), for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, during the pendency of trial, who has been booked in a criminal case arising out of First Information Report, as detailed hereunder:-

case i.e. FIR No. 19/2022 dated 06.04.2022 under Section 22/61/85 NDPS Act registered at Police Station Talwandi Bhai Ki, Ferozepur and there are other two criminal cases registered against her i.e. FIR No. 106/2013 dated 26.07.2013 under Section 15/61/85 NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd and FIR No. 39/2020 dated 21.04.2020 under Section 22/61/85 NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Talwandi Bhai Ki, Ferozepur.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the present petition at this stage.
5. Dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.
