This petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS read with section 528 BNSS, for extension of interim bail granted for six days by the Court of Addl. Session Judge, Kurukshetra, vide order dated 12.6.2025 (Annexure P-3) may be extended for a period of 1 ½ month, in FIR No.786 registered on dated 13.12.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Section 109, 115(2), 118(1), 190, 191, 351(3), 3(5) Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023 registered at P.S. Krishna Gate, Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are various rites and rituals which are to be performed by the petitioner of his deceased brother and after one and a half month a religious ceremony will be held for prayers by family members and relatives and food will be served to people.

On a query put by this Court, counsel for the petitioner informs the Court that the religious ceremony will be held on 11.07.2025.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, learned State Counsel appearing on advance notice, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and has no objection if the the petitioner is allowed to attend that religious ceremony.

In light of the above, respondent-State is directed to take the petitioner in police custody at the place where the rituals are to be performed on 11.07.2025 and he shall be taken back after completion of the religious ceremony on that very day.

The petition stands disposed of with above said observations.
