The present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNNS, 2023, has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Habeas Corpus* for appointing a Warrant Officer, for the release of his minor daughter Kajal aged about 17 years, who is stated to be in illegal confinement of Respondents No.4 to 7, since the intervening night of 17/18.03.2024.

Learned State counsel, on instruction of ASI Resham Singh submits that FIR No. 48, dated 25.03.2024, under Sections 363, 366-A IPC stands registered against respondents No.4, 5 and Ajay Singh at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka. He further submits that after the registration of FIR respondents No.4 and 5 have been arrested and the investigation is under way. He further submits that the after the recovery of the alleged detainee, who is now in the safe custody of mother, nothing survives in the present petition.

In the light of above, no cause of action survives, hence, the present petition is disposed off, as having been rendered infructuous.
