DEEPINDER SINGH NALWA, J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 17.04.2013 (Annexure P-5) vide which persons junior to the petitioner were promoted to the post of Motor Mechanic and Work Experience Teacher.

2. An additional affidavit dated 16.11.2017 of Harvinder Kaur, Assistant Director (Vocational) O/o Director Public Instruction (Secondary Education), Punjab on behalf of respondent Nos.1 &2 has been filed. In para No.4 of the said additional affidavit, it has been mentioned that persons who were junior to the petitioner promoted to the post of Motor Mechanic and Work Experience Teacher, had been reverted vide order dated 16.03.2016. It has also been mentioned that the abovesaid order of reversions were challenged in the writ petition being CWP-5995-2016 and in other writ petitions. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the abovesaid writ petitions were disposed of vide order dated 20.11.2024 by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court. A perusal of the abovesaid order would show that petitioners therein were permitted to continue on the post in question till fresh order is passed.

3. Taking into consideration the order passed in CWP-5995-2016 and



in other connected cases by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly submits that as now, fresh order has to be passed, the writ petition may be disposed of as not pressed. However, liberty may be granted to the petitioner to challenge the fresh order which is to be passed in terms of order dated 20.11.2024 in case, persons junior to the petitioner are again promoted on the post in question.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as not pressed with liberty as prayed for.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
