Challenge in the present writ petition is to the impugned order dated 28.12.2015 passed by respondent No.3-General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Rewari, District Rewari whereby the claim of the petitioners for stepping up of their pay equivalent to their juniors has been ordered to be rejected and a further prayer to direct the respondents to refix the pay of the petitioners by stepping up the same equivalent/at par with the juniors to the petitioners and pay them all consequential benefits including arrears of difference of pay alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

Counsel for the petitioners has moved an application bearing CM-8586-CWP-2025 to dispose of the present writ petition in terms of the judgment passed by this Court in CWP-11710-2014 titled as ***“Sarbars Singh and others versus State of Haryana and others”*** decided on 25.03.2025.

The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case with a direction to the respondents to treat this writ petition as a representation and to take a considered decision in light of the judgment

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dated 25.03.2025 passed in CWP-11710-2014 titled as ***“Sarbens Singh and others versus State of Haryana and others”***, within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that in the event the petitioners are found eligible for the benefits as claimed in the light of the judgment passed by the Hon’ble Division Bench, the necessary benefits shall be released to them within a further period of two months.
