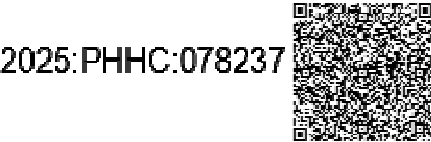

This petition under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS, 2023) has been filed seeking direction to the official respondents to investigate the matter related to case FIR No.874 dated 16.11.2024, under Sections 115, 351(2), 85 & 89 of BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station Karnal through Central Bureau of Investigation or through Chandigarh Police by constituting Special Investigation Team having its member not below the rank of Superintendent of Police (SP).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 28.05.2025 (Annexure P15) before the Director General of Police, Haryana (respondent No.1), raising her grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereupon. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to the Director General of Police, Haryana (respondent No.1), to consider and decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and to take necessary action thereupon.



3. Notice of motion.
4. Served with an advance copy of the petition, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to the Director General of Police, Haryana (respondent No.1) to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 28.05.2025 (Annexure P15) of the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
6. Needless to say, if any threat perception is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide her adequate security in order to protect her life and liberty.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
