1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of directions to official respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

2. On 23.06.2025, following order was passed:

“1. Both the petitioners, i.e., Arju, aged 27 years and Javed, aged 33 years, have filed instant petition for seeking protection to their lives and liberty, as both of them are living in live-in relationship.

2. Petitioner No.1 is already married to respondent No.4 – Gulam Sabir, and three children are borne out of the said wedlock. Two of the children, i.e, aged 5 years (son) and 2 years (daughters) are residing with petitioner No.1, whereas, another daughter (aged 4 years) is residing with respondent No.4.

Not only this, both the petitioners are private respondents No.4 to 12 are residents of District Haridwar (Uttarakhand), and there being no conclusive proof available on record about, if any, in the States of Punjab, Haryana and U.T. Chandigarh, instant protection petition would not be maintainable before this Court.

3. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners to explain the situation.

4. In the interest of justice, adjourned to 08.07.2025.

3. Today, at the very outset learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition.



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4. Dismissed as withdrawn as prayed for.
