1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 – The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to consider and decide the representation dated 29.05.2025 (Annexure P-6), submitted by him in a time bound manner.
2. Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Somnath (No. 685/Ludhiana), informs the Court that with regard to the incident in question, FIR No.40 dated 14.05.2025 has been registered under Sections 115(2), 351(1), and 324(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) at Police Station Division No.4, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana. In the said FIR, petitioner himself has been named as accused, and proceedings in this regard are also pending.
3. It is further submitted that representation made by the petitioner was duly looked into, and in pursuance thereof, DDR No.14 dated 26.05.2025 was registered under Section 115(2) of the BNS, at the

same police station. Upon investigation, it was found that injuries allegedly sustained by the petitioner, are simple in nature.

4. This Court has heard arguments advanced by counsel for both the parties.

5. Considering that FIR and DDR have already been registered based on the respective versions of the parties, this Court finds no reason to issue any further direction in the present petition. Accordingly, **same is dismissed.**
