SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to decide the representations dated 02.06.2025(P-1) and 16.06.2025 (P-2).

Upon perusal of the representations and the pleadings raised in the instant petition, this Court finds that there is no occasion to exercise its inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. The petitioners remain at liberty to proceed in accordance with law, as has been consistently emphasized by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Sakiri Vasu v. State of U.P. and others, 2008 (2) SCC 409, and M. Subramaniam and another v. S. Janaki and another, 2020 (2) RCR (Criminal) 788.
