1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner namely Navdeep Mathur @ Rambo, for grant of Anticipatory Bail, in case FIR No.30 dated 24.02.2025 registered under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 191(3), 190 BNSS and subsequently added offences under Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act and 125,118(2) BNSS, vide G.D. No.17 dated 16.03.2025, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner namely Navdeep Mathur @ Rambo, is alleged to have been armed with a stick and is accused of inflicting blows on the right elbow and wrist of the injured. It is further submitted that co-accused Naseeb Singh has already been granted interim anticipatory bail, vide order dated 25.06.2025 passed in CRM-M-32899-2025, despite the allegation against him of having fired a shot in the air.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance notice, Mr. Neeraj Madaan, Sr. DAG, Punjab, puts an appearance on behalf of the respondent/State.

5. Court is informed by learned State counsel that three of the accused, namely Bhinder Singh, Gurwinder Singh, and Bikramjeet Singh, have already been arrested. It is further submitted that petitioners, namely Navdeep Mathur @ Rambo (petitioner herein) and Kanwaljit Singh @ Goggi (in CRM-M-23059-2025), have filed the petitions before this Court.

6. Counsel for the petitioner submits petitioner is ready to join investigation and to fully cooperate, if protected from arrest by this Court. Thus, prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present cases.

7. At this stage, learned State counsel informs the Court that petitioner, Navdeep Mathur @ Rambo, has been attributed of causing stick blows on the right elbow and wrist of the injured, and one of the injuries, specifically on the wrist, has been declared grievous in nature. In total, the injured sustained nine injuries, out of which four are classified as grievous, having resulted in fractures.

Court is also informed that, subsequent to the incident, complainant-injured, Harjinder Kumar @ Rahul, has been murdered by some of the accused involved in the present case.

8. Taking into consideration all the circumstances and the facts placed before this Court, no substantial ground is found to grant the discretionary relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Navdeep Mathur @ Rambo, as he has been specifically attributed with causing one of the grievous injuries on the wrist of the injured. Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed.
