SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

1. Prayer in the instant petition, filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to provide protection of lives and liberty to the petitioners, who have married against the wishes of the private respondents.

2. On 23.06.2025, following order was passed by this Court:

“1. Through instant petition, petitioners, i.e. Rashid, aged 19 years and Najrana, aged 18 years, have prayed for protection of the life and liberty, which is at stake at the hands of private respondents No. 4 and 5.

2. Both the petitioners are ‘Mohammedan’ by religion. It is averred that petitioner No.1 is already married with one ‘Jenat’ and one child was born out of the said wedlock.

3. Credential of petitioner No.1, who is of the age of 19 years and already married, be confirmed.

4. List again on 07.07.2025.”

3. Today, learned State Counsel has filed a status report by way of an affidavit of Abhimanu, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police,

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Tauru. Same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned State Counsel submits that the statements of both petitioners have already been recorded, wherein they have expressed that, as of now, there is no threat perception and that they have no apprehension, nor do they require any protection.

4. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for.
