1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, with the following substantive prayer:

"i. Issue writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondent's No. 3, to protect the life petitioners and liberty of the from the hands respondents from. the hands respondents No.4 to 8

ii. Further to comply with the provisions of Section 179 BNSS. before calling the petitioner to the Police Station. And to Decide the Representation 03.06.2025 (Annexure P-2).

iii. It is further prayed that this Hon'ble Court may issue any other appropriate writ, order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in facts & circumstances of the case."

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer and submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, for the *nonce*, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider and take a conscious decision on the representation (Annexure P-2) made by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.



4. On the strength of the advance notice, Mr. Jatinder Pal Singh, Senior DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. He submits he has no objection in case the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, is accepted.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the rival parties and have perused the paper-book with their assistance.
6. Keeping in view the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case & without going into merits thereof, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police Tarn Taran (respondent No.3 herein) to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioner; objectively consider the grievance(s) raised in the said representation & take ratiocinated decision thereupon after affording opportunity of hearing to petitioner, in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks from today. Such decision be communicated to the petitioner within fifteen days of it being taken.
7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
