The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.0047 dated 06.06.2025 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 24.06.2025, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 16.08.2025 by way of an affidavit of Tejinder Pal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Abohar (Rural), District Fazilka has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 24.06.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands disposed of.
