Main Case

Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (For short "BNSS"), the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0005 dated 08.01.2023 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali (Annexure P-2).



2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 24.06.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Kewal Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 24.06.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
