1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.73 dated 25.03.2025 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal, Haryana.

2. While granting concession of interim anticipatory bail on 24.06.2025, the following contentions were noticed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court :

*“Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia submits
that the present is a dispute of civil nature and even a civil suit*



for declaration as well as partition application are pending between the parties, who happens to be co-sharers. He further submits that the petitioners are ready & willing to join the investigation.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has reiterated the submissions and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

4. Status report by way of affidavit of Bir Bhan, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (HQ), Kaithal has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today and the same is taken on record.

5. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no longer required for further investigation.

6. On the other hand, learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the submissions on the ground that the petitioners are involved in a serious crime.

7. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

8. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 24.06.2025 is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S.
