1. This is a Criminal Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus with a roving writ, the Warrant Officer may kindly be appointed to visit the spot or issuance of direction to respondent no.2 to produce / release the detenue and be released from the illegal custody of respondent no.3.

2. Learned State counsel has produced the order passed by the Duty / Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nuh dated 23.06.2025 to show that an FIR no.187 dated 19.06.2025 has been registered under Sections 305, 331(4) of BNS in Pune. The petitioner has been implicated as an accused and a transit



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remand of the accused persons including present petitioner has been granted for 5 days.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the arrest in the abovesaid case has been shown at 1:20 pm on 23.06.2025 whereas the present petition has been filed on 23.06.2025, prior to the abovesaid time. It is submitted that in view of the fact that the petitioner has been arrested, the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the petitioner to pursue his legal remedy, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with the aforesaid liberty.
