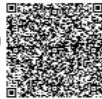

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.168, dated 05.06.2025 registered under Sections 190, 191 (3), 115, 351(3), 126, 140(3), 75(2) of BNS 2023 at Police Station Sector 17, HUDA, Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar. ((In the order dated 20.06.2025 (Annexure P-4), offence under Sections 126(2) and 75 of the BNS has been recorded, whereas, in the FIR, Sections 126 and 75(2) has been recorded).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 25.06.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigation Officer and has joined the investigation.



3. Learned State counsel on instructions has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 25.06.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C/482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
