1. All the above mentioned writ petitions were filed in the year 2017, challenging an amendment dated 02.10.2017, introduced in the marketing guidelines for allotment of retail outlets. The amendment was assailed before the other High Courts, including High Court of Delhi. The matter was decided by the High Court of Delhi, affirming the amendments so made. In a challenge made to the judgment of High Court of Delhi, the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP (C) No.11322 of 2022, titled '*All Haryana Petroleum Dealers Association and others vs. Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. and others*' decided on 22.10.2024, had passed the hereinafter extracted order :-

"These matters have been taken up on a mention being made by learned Solicitor General of India appearing for the that in all these six matters, respondents, stating settlement have been arrived at between the parties and as such these petitions may be disposed of in terms of the Settlement Agreement(s).

All the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and respondents in the respective cases are present and are ad idem with learned Solicitor General.

Accordingly, applications (IA 231024/2024, Nos. 231026/2024, 231031/2024, 231381/2024, 231384/2024 and as also 231377/2024) annexing the Settlement Agreements applications bearing I.A. Nos. 230999/2024 and 232704/2024 are allowed and these petitions are disposed of in terms of the settlement arrived at between the respective parties.

It is made clear that these matters have been disposed of on the basis of the settlement arrived at between the parties and the Court has not examined any of the issues on merit.

Pending applications, including intervention shall stand disposed of. Impleadment/intervention shall stand disposed of.”

2. Separate applications have been filed by the respondents No.2 to 4, in each case, stating therein that the present petitions be also disposed of, in terms of order (supra), passed by the Hon’ble Supreme Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) does not oppose the prayer made on behalf of the respective respondents.

4. In that view of the matter, all the above mentioned writ petitions, which were adjourned *sine die*, are hereby revived and taken on board today itself.

5. In view of the prayer made by learned counsel for the respective respondents, all the above mentioned writ petitions are **disposed of**, in terms of the observations made by Hon’ble Supreme Court in ‘*All Haryana*



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and others’ decided on 22.10.2024.

- 6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of accordingly.
