Challenge in the present writ petition is to the order dated 25.05.2018 (Annexure P-11) passed by respondent No.4-Deputy Inspector General (Admin), Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), New Delhi whereby the respondents had rejected the claim of the petitioner for the liberalized pensionary award.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that during the pendency of the instant writ petition, the respondents have recalculated the liberalized pensionary award and have extended the benefit, however, the arrears are still pending.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent on the other hand contends that the admissible benefits have already been

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released.

Be that as it may, since the respondents have already accepted the entitlement of the petitioner to the liberalized pensionary award under the applicable scheme, hence, the respondents are directed to ascertain the arrears which became admissible and send an intimation to the petitioner about the disbursement of the said arrears in a time bound manner and preferably within a period of 06 weeks of a receipt of certified copy of this order. It is made clear that in the event any dues/arrears are yet admissible and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be released in a time bound manner and preferably within a period of two months thereafter.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
