The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.39 dated 05.12.2023 registered under Sections 420, 218, 120-B, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 13 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at P.S. ACB, Gurugram, District Anti Corruption Bureau, Haryana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 27.06.2025 **passed** by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Raj Kiran submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders



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dated 27.06.2025 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 27.06.2025 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
