1. In the present writ petition, the petitioners are praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the notification dated 04.06.2025 (Annexure P-1 and P-2), which has been advertised in various newspapers.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been working on the posts which have been advertised for a considerable long period of time as such, petitioners are entitled for the above said posts which have been advertised.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, on instructions from petitioners, further submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if the present writ petition be treated as a representation and a direction is given to respondent No.4 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

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5. Mr. Himanshu Raj, Addl. Advocate General, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 3 and Mr. Vikas Singh, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 4 and do not object to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners. Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply complete copies of the paper-book to learned counsel for the respondents, during the course of the day.

6. In view of above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to treat the present writ petition as a representation and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

7. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
