The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents no.4 to 7 from harassing them or interfering in their peaceful life.

On an advance notice, Mr. Sandeep Vashisht, APP, caused appearance on behalf of official respondents-UT, Chandigarh, and has placed on record a statement suffered by petitioners, before the police authorities, which reveals that the present petitioners do not have any threat perceptions. The said statement is ordered to be taken on record as Mark 'A'.
