The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0019 dated 01.05.2024 registered under Sections 120-B, 201, 409, 420, 465, 467, 471 IPC ad Section 13 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at P.S. ACB Gurugram, District Gurugram.
