JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent not to replace her with another *ad hoc*/contractual teacher till the regular appointment on the post of Assistant Professor.

2. The petitioner claims that she is working with respondent-College since 2016 and she should not be replaced by another contractual employee. She may be replaced by a regular employee but she cannot be replaced by a contractual employee.

3. Mr. Cheema submits that in 2024, interview was conducted. The petitioner participated in the interview and her name figured at Sr. No.2 in the waiting list. There were 4 vacancies and 3 candidates have occupied their post. One post is lying vacant and petitioner may be considered for the said post.

Tribunal, nevertheless, considering the statement of Mr. Cheema, instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent to consider claim of petitioner for the vacant post. The respondent is expected that it would take into account experience of the petitioner.

5. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
