HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents relies upon a communication dated 25.03.2025, to submit that the claim of the petitioners with respect to grant of benefits of minimum of pay scale under 7th Pay Commission along with DA has been accepted and the actual benefits in lieu thereof shall be released in their favour within 08 weeks from today.

2. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of. However, in case, the petitioners are aggrieved of the order dated 25.03.2025, they would be at liberty to avail their remedies as per law. Rule stands discharged.

3. It is further made clear that in case needful is not done, as per undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present

contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application, if any.

4. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of.
