1. An affidavit on behalf of the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram has been filed and the same is taken on record.
2. Learned State counsel while referring to the affidavit stated that upon further scrutiny of the case, it was found that the concerned police officer who did not register the FIR, failed to perform his duty properly and against him disciplinary proceedings have been ordered and now FIR No. 14 dated 14.01.2025 under Section 306 IPC has been registered against accused Vikas. He also referred to para Nos.12 and 13 of the said affidavit to state that the Deputy Commissioner of Police, West Gurugram, had directed the SHO of Police Station, Rajendra Park, Gurugram to personally conduct the investigation of the case and the Commissioner of Police has further directed the Deputy Commissioner of Police, West Gurugram to personally supervise the investigation on a fortnightly basis. In para No.14 of the affidavit filed by



the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram, assurance is given to this Court that the investigation shall be conducted fairly, diligently and in accordance with law and shall be completed expeditiously.

3. In view of the aforesaid affidavit filed by the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram, this Court is of the view that the present petition can be disposed of, as the same has been rendered infructuous.

4. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
