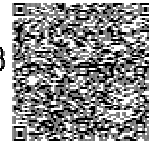

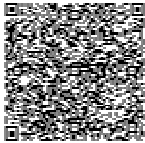

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 for taking action against respondent No. 4 and 5 and others on the representations dated 08.04.2024 and 21.05.2024 (Annexures P-5 and P-6) and also to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 and other persons.

2. Upon notice, reply has been filed by the respondent-State. It is submitted therein and learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana has argued that on receipt of the aforesaid representations from the petitioner, the same were duly inquired into by the DSP, Hq., Yamuna Nagar, whereby the petitioner was called upon several times to join the inquiry but he did not turn up. However, his brother, namely Gulfan Ali, had appeared and made statement that the petitioner was not mentally fit. After conducting thorough inquiry in the aforesaid representations, it was found that the petitioner had

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levelled false and baseless allegations the police officials and hence both the representations were filed. It is also submitted that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner could not dispute the factual position.

4. Keeping in view the position explained above, no case is made out to issue any direction to respondents No. 2 and 3. Hence, the present petition is disposed of. The petitioner is granted liberty to avail his alternative remedies in accordance with law, if so advised.
