KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, as cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made for issuance of direction upon respondent No.2, to decide the statutory appeal (Annexure P-12), although the same has been dismissed with the observations by the authority concerned that no adjudication is required on account of the fact that the suspension period is already over, however, yet the authority concerned is required to adjudicate the appeal after giving due opportunity to the petitioner, as the order of suspension, which till date has not been set-aside by any competent authority would in future cause prejudice to the petitioner.

2. The prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner seems to be bonafide, therefore, the authority concerned, which has refused to adjudicate the appeal, so preferred by the petitioner, is directed to decide the appeal on merits, after giving due opportunity to the parties concerned.
