KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a mandamus, upon the respondents, to constitute the Medical Health Review Board and to decide the petition dated 05.04.2023 (Annexure P-1), as filed by the petitioner under the Mental Health Care Act, 2017, for appointment of legal guardian.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition dated 05.04.2023 (Annexure P-1), preferred by the petitioner, has not been decided till date, despite the same being pending for the last more than one year. The indolent and lackadaisical approach of the respondents, has propelled the petitioner to file the instant petition, before this Court.
3. This Court, vide order dated 02.07.2025, had passed the hereafter extracted order, upon the instant petition :-

“Learned counsel for the State, is directed to have apt instructions from the quarter concerned, and to inform this Court, as to how much time is required to decided the

application, so preferred by the petitioner.

List this matter on 04.07.2025.”

4. Today, learned counsel for the State, on instructions imparted to him from the competent authority concerned, informs this Court, that final decision on the application/petition dated 05.04.2023 (Annexure P-1), as filed by the petitioner, shall be taken by the competent authority concerned, within a period of eight weeks from today.

5. In view of the specific statement, as made by the learned counsel for the State, before this Court, no further order is required to be passed in the instant writ petition, and the same is hereby **closed**.

6. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**.
