1. Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 483 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail in FIR No.42 dated
12.02.2025, under Section 376 of IPC 1860, registered at Police Station Civil
Lines Batala, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel representing State, on instructions from ASI
Nirmal Singh, No.2251, Police Station Batala, pointed out that petitioner – Harjit
Singh has been acquitted by learned trial Court in above said FIR on 18.08.2025.
3. In view of the aforesaid factual position, learned counsel for
petitioner states that he does not want to pursue the present regular bail petition
and accordingly withdraws the same.
