MAIN CASE

Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to process, sanction and release the medical reimbursement claim submitted by the petitioner on 01.06.2017 for an amount of Rs.1,25,285/-, which has been withheld by the respondents without any justified reason.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondents-U.O.I. has apprised that the claim of the petitioner for reimbursement of the medical expenses has already been processed and an amount of Rs.53,511/- has been sanctioned, which shall be released in favour of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous at this stage, but he may be granted liberty to take recourse to the appropriate remedy for seeking disbursement of the differential claim, if so admissible to him in accordance with law.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, with liberty to the petitioner as aforesaid.
