**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to count his daily wage service for the purpose of retiral benefits.
2. The petitioner claims that he joined respondent as Class-IV daily wage worker on 12.04.1981. He was regularized as Cleaner on 12.03.1992. He superannuated and at the time of his retirement, he was paid retiral benefits without counting his service as daily wage worker.
3. Mr. Sandeep Thakan, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that case of petitioner is squarely covered by order dated 30.04.2024 passed



by this Court in **CWP-15602-2023, Baljeet Singh vs. Managing Director, HVPNL and others.**

4. Mr. Raman Sharma, Advocate, who on advance notice is present in Court, expressed his inability to controvert afore-stated factual and legal position.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent to consider claim of petitioner in the light of order dated 30.04.2024 passed by this Court in **Baljeet Singh (supra)** and order dated 07.02.2025 passed by Executive Engineer, HVPNL, Jind. Let the needful be done within 2 months from today. It is made clear that arrears will not carry interest.
