MANISHA BATRA, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 and to take action on his complaint dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-1).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has recently filed a complaint on 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-1) before the Commissioner of Police (Rural), Jagraon, District Ludhiana, raising his grievance as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to decide the aforesaid complaint filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.



3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Himani Arora, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid complaint dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner, the official respondents to take further action and provide him adequate security in order to protect their life and liberty.
