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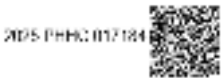

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner while limiting his arguments submits that the petitioner is wrongly declared as proclaimed person vide order dated 15.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) by the Court concerned. It is further submitted that now the matter has been compromised between the parties vide Annexure P-3 and otherwise also order Annexure P-2 was not passed in consonance with the mandatory provision of Section 82 Cr.P.C. and the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the learned Trial Court.

3. Mr. Kuldeep Singh Siwach, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of complainant/respondent No.2 and has filed memo of appearance which is taken on record. Counsel for respondent No.2 has admitted the factum of compromise and further submits that he is having no objection if the

impugned order Annexure P-2 is set aside.



4. Mr. Jatinderpal Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that the present petition be disposed of in accordance with law.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the impugned order dated 15.07.2023 is hereby set aside with direction to the petitioner to appear before the learned Trial Court within next 10 days and to seek bail in accordance with law.
