The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita with a prayer for directing the Respondents No. 2 to 4 not to make inquiries time and again at the instance of the Respondent No.5 which is being made after the submission of reports dated 11.04.2024 (Annexure P-3), 12.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) and 12.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) on the application dated 22.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) submitted by respondent no.5 and again notices dated 10.12.2024 (Annexure P-6), 22.01.2025 (Annexure P-7) in Complaint 2927, DGP dated 05.12.2024 are being issued by respondent no.4, in contravention of Notification/ instructions issued by the respondent no.2 (Annexure P-8) as well as the Law laid down by the Constitutional Bench of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in Lalita Kumari vs Govt. of UP and others 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979 and this Hon'ble Court in Jaswinder Singh vs State of Punjab

CRM M-18244 of 2008 Dated 12.1.2009 and CRM M-16013 of 2020 in the view of the facts and circumstances of the case against the provisions of law.

At the very outset, learned State counsel, on instructions, apprised the Court that the inquiry has already been conducted and concluded by the competent authorities, as reflected in the order dated 02.07.2025, which is hereby taken on record.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
