This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondent No. 4 to 7 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful married life of the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, learned State Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, who assures the Court that necessary action will be taken on the representation dated 30.06.2025 (Annexure P-5) after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, by passing a speaking order within a period of two days

from today, in the light of notification No.HOMEHM-4040SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch). He though informs the Court that statement of private respondents have been recorded who stated that they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners and will not give any threat to them.

In light of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the instant petition any further.

The present petition stands dismissed as not pressed.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure as per law, in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.
