1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a *mandamus* upon respondents no.2 and 5 to decide the legal notice dated 02.05.2025 (Annexure P-7), wherethrough, the petitioners have requested to consider their claim for issuance of sports gradation certificate.

2. This Court on dated 07.07.2025, had passed the hereinafter extracted order:-

“The petitioners have approached this Court, by filing the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, as their legal notice dated 02.05.2025 (Annexure P-7), for issuance of sports gradation certificates, has not been decided, till date.

Before the asked for Mandamus is issued upon the respondents concerned, the learned State counsel is directed to have apt instructions from the quarter concerned, and inform this Court, as to how much is required by the authorities concerned to decide the legal notice of the petitioners (*supra*).

Adjourned to 17.07.2025 ”

3. In deference to the directions (*supra*), today, learned State counsel, on instructions, informs this Court that the claim of the present petitioners for issuance sports gradation certificate would be decided within a month from the date of passing of this order.

4. In view of the aforesaid statement suffered by the learned State counsel, no further direction is required to be passed by this Court. Therefore, the instant petition is ordered to be **closed**.

5. **Disposed of** accordingly.
