SANJAY VASHISTH, J (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents to take appropriate legal action on the representation dated 19.06.2025, filed by him, in view of the judgment passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Lalita Kumari vs. Govt. Of U.P. and others, 2013(4) RCR (Crl.) 979*.

2. As per the facts of the present case, there is an allegation that respondent No.4 stole an amount of Rs.60,000/- which was kept in the Activa belonging to the petitioner. Counsel for the petitioner relied on the CCTV footage in support of his submissions.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance notice, Mr. Neeraj Madaan, Senior DAG, Punjab, appeared on behalf of the respondent/State, and on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh, he submits that the required

inquiry/investigation has already been conducted, and the allegations were found to be not only incorrect but also false. In this regard, rapat No.25 dated 18.06.2025 has already been registered.

5. In view of the above, no direction is required to be passed by this Court, at this stage.

6. Accordingly, present petition stands disposed of.
