Main case

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.469 dated 09.06.2025 registered under Section 7 of P.C. Act, Section 4 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, Section 55 of I.T. Act and Sections 170, 198, 238(a), 316(2), 318(4), 351(3) of BNS at Police Station Azad Nagar, District Hisar, Haryana..

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 04.07.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

It is opposed on the grounds that the complainant faces a threat and an application regarding the threat has been moved. The State counsel submits that the allegations of a threat as mentioned in the application have been found to be incorrect and the application has been filed.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 04.07.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands disposed of.
